Drinking and Selling wine is Prohibited

A humble message for all our Muslim brothers who own/work in Gas Stations

Below are some of many evidences that establish beyond doubt the impermissibility of dealing with alcohol in any way, shape or form. Selling or buying liquor, transporting liquor, serving liquor all of this will lead to Allaah's curse. Our message to gas station owners or who take it easy to work in such environment "repent and come back to Allaah, Allaah is the Most Merciful and Oft-Forgiving."

Allaah says: "O you who believe! Intoxicants (all kinds of alcoholic drinks), and gambling, and Al-Ansaab (stone altars for sacrifices to idols etc..), and Al-Azlaam (arrows for seeking luck or decision) are an abomination of Shaytaan's (Satan's) handiwork. So avoid that in order that you may be successful" [al-Maa'idah 5:90]

The Prophet (saw), who said: "Alcohol is the mother of all evils." [see al-Silsilah al-Saheehah, 1854] The Prophet (saw) said: "When Allaah forbids a thing, He also forbids its price." (Ahmad (2564); Saheeh al-Jaami', 5107). So, alcohol is prohibited, so is prohibited earnings from selling it.

Ibn Abbas reported: Once 'Umar (radiAllaahu 'anhu) was informed that a certain man sold alcohol. 'Umar said, "May Allah curse him! Doesn't he know that Allah's Messenger said, 'May Allah curse the Jews, for Allah had forbidden them to eat the fat of animals but they melted it and sold it.'" (Saheeh Al-Bukhari)

Al-Tirmidhi (1295) reported that Anas ibn Maalik said: The Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) cursed ten with regard to alcohol: the one who squeezes (the grapes etc..), the one for whom it is squeezed, the one who drinks it, the one who carries it, the one to whom it is carried, the one who pours it, the one who sells it and consumes its price, the one who buys it and the one for whom it is bought."
