Innovations regarding Eid days:

- Believing that new clothes are a must! Without new clothes there is no eid. However, there is nothing wrong in buying or wearing new dresses.
- Women wearing exotic dresses without hejab
- Making the takbeer of eid in congregation. One person in charge holding the microphone and screaming the takbeer while others sing the takbeer as a chorus is one of the evil innovation of Eid
- Declaring that takbeer starts at a certain time in the morning! Whereas proper sunnah is to start the takbeer when the believers leave home to come to the eid prayer.
- To believe that Eid-al-fitr should be celebrated three consecutive days. Many countries practice Eid Al Fitr as three days! Eid Al-Fitr is only one day!
- Visiting the grave yard after eid prayer

Innovations of Ramadaan

- Starting the month with calculation and pre-set calendar (not upon seeing the new moon)
- Verbalizing the intention by saying "nuwaytuan asuumu ramadaan" (whereas intention is only in the heart)
- Suhoor is a condition of fasting, the one who didn't eat suhur, can't fast!
- Every good deed in Ramadaan is multiplied and every sin is multiplied
- The punishment of the grave stops in Ramadaan until the musalleen finish the eid prayer.
- Saying and distributing "innovated du'as" to the muslims saying this is good
- Believing that
 - In ramadaan Allaah decorated the paradise
 - First third of this month is a mercy, the middle is forgiveness, and its end is a granting freedom from the fire.
- Some people stop eating and drinking 5-10 minutes before the proper dawn time to be in safe side. They call this imsak. Many imams and masjid even advise the people to practice this. This is a huge bid'ah.
- Delaying the iftar to be in safe side!
- Believing that last jum'ah of Ramadaan has some special merit. They call it "akheri jum'ah " in some cultures, Allaah's refuge is sought from this fitnah
- Doing khatme quran on the 27th of Ramadan and distributing sweets
- Chadni Raat – women gathering and putting henna in the hand on the night of the eid.
- Distributing zakat al fitr in the form of money, not food
- Creating unnecessary rules to make fasting hard
 - You can't put anything in the mouth
 - You can't brush you teeth
 - Can't use perfume

Many of these rules unfortunately are imposed to create extra caution and hence causes the believer unnecessary hardship. They have no foundation in the religion.
- Believing that on laylatul qadr every good deeds are multiplied 1000 months of rewards!
- Bid'ah regarding the taraweeh prayer:
 - Saying innovated du'as after every four rakaat.
 - Fasting is not valid until you pray 20 rakat taraweeh namaaz!
 - Believing those who pray 11 rakat taraweeh are going to hellfire!

Raise your taqwa by donating!

Know the rules donation before you donate, ask if you don't know.... Some quickies...

Doation can't be made from haram sources. If you are selling wine, beer, crosses, pornography and then thinking of donation, then first dear noble brother, repent to Allaah, get a halal job and then donate. So, Allaah will accept from you.

Donation can't be made with credit cards. Credit cards are riba!

Zakat can't be donated for building masjid,
