All about Rajab – “The Sacred Month”

a) Rajab is one of the sacred months and it is forbidden to fight in this month unless it is necessary to defend. We are not supposed to transgress in this month.

b) There is no special reward for good deeds, neither there is any extra punishment for sins in Rajab

c) All the ahadith describing the virtues of fasting, praying, charity of Rajab are weak or fabricated and can't be depended upon.

d) The celebration of 27th of Rajab as laylatul Me'raj is a bid'ah.

e) Any deed done on any other months are allowed to be performed in Rajab. For example: fasting Mondays or Thursdays etc... As long as they are done because it is Rajab.

f) Any deed (big or small, obligatory or optional) if done because it is Rajab then it is a bid'ah.

ex: someone says I will give charity in Rajab because it is Rajab! However, if someone says I am giving charity in Rajab because I can and I am not doing that because it is Rajab then it is ok.

g) The Prophet sallallahu 'alayhi wa sallam and the sahabah never singled out to do any good deeds in Rajab because it is Rajab.

h) It is reported in Musannaf Ibn Abee Shaybah with authentic isnad that some sahabah performed Umrah during Rajab but they didn't do this because it is Rajab!

took it for granted Isra and Me'raj happened on the 26th of Rajab!!!

- For the argument's sake, even if the date was confirmed, we can't perform anything special unless it was done by the Prophet (Sallallahu 'alayhi wa sallam) and his companions. And the true fact is that there is nothing reported from them that they singled out a night to celebrate this event as is done in the name of "Shabe-Me'raj"
- Many scholars of Islam wrote books, treaties, fatwas denouncing the extra prayer, fasting, charity, distribution of sweat meats, singing, dancing that are performed to celebrate this night.

Dear Muslims, we must not blinding follow tradition & culture and imitate such baseless practice. By celebrating such events, we are supporting and promoting clear and pure innovations in the religion and worst of all teaching the next generation to carry the tradition of Iblees and the shayaateen. May Allaah guide us to the truth and protect us from falsehood.

Why We don't celebrate Shabe-Me'raj?

- The event of Isra and Me'raj is true and it happened but nothing is recorded with regards to the event's exact date and time.
- There is a huge disagreement with regards to the date amongst the historians and the scholars of biography/hadith.
- The famous date 26th of Rajab is one of the dates that is chosen by some scholars (but none of them said with confirmation this is the date). The common mass due to the ignorance
